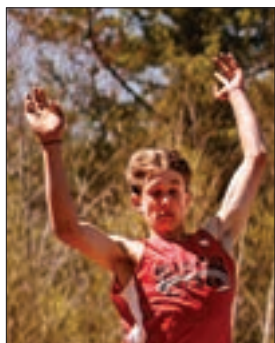

## New \$8.1-million outdoor pool set to open in Liverpool

LIVERPOOL – The South Queens outdoor pool is “very, very close” to opening, Region of Queens Mayor Scott Christian said Wednesday.

“We have staff training over there. We got the keys. There’s a couple things with getting the water going, getting the systems going, a couple things that we’re continuing to work through. But we have possession of the facility from the construction company.”

Axios Construction officials recently took some local politicians on a tour of the

\$8.1-million site. The heated, 25-metre, six-lane facility was approved in June 2023, after years of lobbying by local

residents for a year-round, indoor pool.

The region secured \$3 million from an anonymous donor and \$2.2 million from the province for the project. It’s picking up the remaining \$2.9-million tab.

Soon after the October 2024 municipal election, where Christian campaigned on an indoor pool, councillors voted to stick with the existing outdoor facility. Senior staff told them that changing the project in midstream could cost up to \$30 million.

Christian said that the region has been able to find enough instructors to staff the pool in its first year.

## Man dies after being shot by police in Chelsea

CHELSEA – A man is dead after being shot by a member of the RCMP.

The man was shot by an RCMP officer at an incident in Chelsea on the morning of July 9. The matter was handed over to the Serious Incident Response Team (SiRT).

In their latest release issued July 10 at about 2:30 p.m. SiRT announced that the man had died at the scene – a point left out of RCMP news releases from July 8 and 9.

No name was released.

What we know – from the RCMP files... On the morning of July 9, members of

the Lunenburg District RCMP responded to a report of a possession of a firearm who was linked to an ongoing investigation from the day before.

That day at 9 a.m., the Lunenburg District RCMP responded to a report of a person in possession of a weapon on Hwy. 210 near Chelsea.

Officers identified the man as the same person associated to an ongoing investigation about a suspicious person potentially in possession of a weapon from the previous day. He was the subject of an Alert Ready emergency alert in Lunenburg and Queens counties on July 8.

During the RCMP response, an officer discharged their firearm. The man sus-

tained injuries consistent with a gunshot wound, according to the RCMP news release which indicated the officers provided first aid on scene.

No other injuries were reported.

**JULY 8**

At 6 p.m.

An alert went out with the details: Dangerous man with a weapon – Hwy. 210 and Old Chelsea Rd.

The suspect was described as a man in his 30s, dark hair with beard, brown bandana and pants, grey shirt and black satchel bag.

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# Mahone Bay prepares to shine as Communities in Bloom judges return

MAHONE BAY - Mahone Bay is once again getting ready to show its community spirit as it takes part in Communities in Bloom, a program that encourages towns across Canada and beyond to improve their surroundings through beautification and civic involvement.

While bright flower beds and tidy gardens are the most visible parts of the effort, members of Mahone Bay’s local Communities in Bloom committee say the program means far more than appearances. They see it as a chance to build partnerships, celebrate local heritage, and inspire residents to take pride in the town they call home.

Communities in Bloom is an international program that evaluates towns in several areas, including horticulture, environmental action, heritage conservation, urban forestry, and community engagement. Instead of judging themselves, Mahone Bay’s committee serves as the local organizing group that co-ordinates participation and hosts visiting judges.

“We aren’t assessing; the judges do,” explained committee member Penny Carver.

The committee includes 10 to 12 volunteers representing different organizations throughout Mahone Bay.

“We represent Mahone Bay on the Bloom team,” said Carver. “It’s a national and international organization meant to instate civic pride and development. Coming together to make the place the best it can be.” Mahone Bay first became involved after the town council received an invitation video to join in 2024.

“We watched it together and thought, ‘Wow, we can do that,’” Carver recalled.

After organizing its first submission, the community welcomed judges for an evaluation that year. Mahone Bay earned a rating of four out of five blooms, along with a special award, results the committee says it was pleased to achieve during its first participation.

Preparing for the judges involves much more than tending gardens. The evaluation includes visits to a range of community sites, each showing different sides

of the town’s character and achievements.

“The tour guide lists all the stops,” Carver explained. “At every stop, a community member will be available to talk about their project.” That means local organizations, businesses, and volunteers all take part in telling Mahone Bay’s story.

At the Mahone Bay Boatyard Co-operative, for instance, volunteers show how young people learn traditional boatbuilding skills while keeping the area’s maritime heritage alive.

“The two community members who work there, who aren’t part of the committee, will be there to tell the judge about their project and why it’s important for heritage,” said Carver.

After the 2024 evaluation, judges provided several pages of detailed feedback outlining both strengths and areas for improvement.

Committee member Sylvia Jackson said some of the suggestions are already being put into action.

“One of the things was the connection along Edgewater, which is almost done,” she said.

The judges also encouraged the town to include more decorative scarecrows beyond festival seasons. While committee members liked the idea, they decided on a simpler approach.

“We agreed to a couple, because we didn’t want to maintain them all the time,” Jackson said.

Other suggestions focused on municipal infrastructure and public safety.

Carver said judges noticed that vegetation near some parking lot exits was blocking drivers’ sightlines and recommended removing certain invasive plant species. They also encouraged the committee to adopt a more formal organizational structure.

That recommendations have already led to change.

“We’ve become a subcommittee of the chamber of commerce here,” Carver said.

The committee admits that sharing judges’ recommendations throughout the community is another area still developing.

“We weren’t very organized about that in 2024,” Carver admitted. “Certainly we shared it with the town since that’s where most of the issues were raised. But

it’s something we’re looking to improve. We’re literally inventing the process as we go.” After participating non-competitively in 2025, Mahone Bay is returning to competition this year in the category for towns with populations under 5,000 residents. With just over 1,000 people, committee members believe the town is well placed to showcase the strengths of a small but active community.

Beyond organized projects, though, the committee hopes residents will embrace the spirit of Communities in Bloom in their own neighbourhoods.

“Mow the lawn,” committee member Vicki Bardon said with a laugh. “Pretend you’re being judged every day.” She follows that advice herself.

“My door isn’t painted, but I’m trying to paint my door before the judges even arrive. The judges may not even see my house, but it matters.”

For the committee, that attitude captures the program’s larger purpose. Instead of cleaning up for a single visit, they hope participation inspires year-round pride in the community.

When asked if they have already noticed a difference since Mahone Bay joined Communities in Bloom, the committee members all gave the same answer.

“Yes!” Bardon believes the reason is simple.

“Because everyone should have pride in their town.” Carver agrees, noting that Mahone Bay has changed greatly over the past few decades.

“Mahone Bay, a couple of decades ago, was really on the skids,” she said. “It began to change when new people moved in with new businesses. These kinds of visible, thriving enterprises really helped boost community pride.” For her, Communities in Bloom builds on that momentum by encouraging residents, businesses, volunteers, and local organizations to work toward a shared goal.

“And what’s wrong with community pride?” she said.

As Mahone Bay prepares to welcome judges once again, committee members hope the evaluation will recognize not only the beautiful gardens and street-scapes, but also the cooperation and volunteer spirit that continue to shape the town’s future.

The alert urged people in the area to find a safe location, lock your doors and do not pick up hitchhikers.

In an update at 8:05 p.m.

RCMP officers are in Chelsea continuing the investigation into the man with a weapon. At this time, the alert instructions remain for Lunenburg County and Queens County.

At 8:51 p.m.

As a result of ongoing investigative efforts, officers no longer believe there’s a risk to public safety. The alert for Chelsea has been cancelled. Investiga-

tors remain in the area as they continue the investigation. Residents may resume normal activities. Thank you for your support.

A cancellation has been issued to residents in Lunenburg County and Queens County:

RCMP alert has ended for a person with weapon in Chelsea, Nova Scotia.

Threat ended.

Officers remain in the area to investigate. Residents may resume normal activities.

SiRT independently investigates all serious incidents which arise from the actions of police in Nova Scotia. There does not have to be an allegation of wrongdoing.





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# Mahone Bay’s Faerie Garden brings a touch of magic to Communities in Bloom efforts

MAHONE BAY - Mahone Bay’s Faerie Garden adds some whimsy to Communities in Bloom efforts.

As part of Mahone Bay’s ongoing Communities in Bloom initiative, residents are looking past traditional gardens and landscaping to create something a little more whimsical.

Next to Suttles & Seawinds, founded by Vicky Bardon, the Mahone Bay Faerie Garden stands as a community-led project meant to bring beauty, spark engagement, and add a sense of wonder to the town.

A faerie garden is a small garden space filled with miniature pieces like tiny houses, pathways, furniture, and natural details that seem to belong to mythical faerie dwellers. Often tucked among plants, trees, or flowers, these gardens invite visitors to slow down, wander, and let their imagination take over.

For the women behind Mahone Bay’s faerie garden, the goal was to create more than just decoration. They wanted to build a shared experience that would inspire both residents and visitors to connect with the town in a new way.

“I read a story on tourism in Victoria, BC, and something that draws people to visit is that the residents created a faerie trail along the sidewalks of their neighbourhoods,” said Bardon. “I thought that we could do that and bring a sense of magic.”

The idea slowly turned into a project where visitors could interact with the faeries themselves. Along the trail, the faeries are imagined to have their own way of communicating, including a wish process where visitors can write a note and place it in a special box.

The start of the project also carries personal meaning for one of its creators.

Sylvia Jackson of the Community in Bloom committee credited fellow organizer Kate Cocks with shaping the idea after drawing inspiration from her Scottish upbringing.

“She was raised by a Scottish mother and ‘take ‘em to the faeries’ was a common threat in her house,” Jackson said, describing the playful phrase that helped spark the concept.

What began as an idea among a few volunteers has grown into a lar-

ger community effort. At first, three women worked on building the faerie houses, but the project has since expanded to include about eight people helping with construction and design.

The faerie garden reflects the broader goals of Communities in Bloom. It’s part of a wider effort for towns to improve public spaces through resident involvement, not just the addition of floral arrangements and a fresh coat of paint alone.

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# Liverpool man charged after series of collisions

LIVERPOOL - Queens District RCMP has charged a man after he struck multiple vehicles on Hwy. 3 and fled the area.

On July 3, at approximately 2 p.m., Queens District RCMP began receiving reports of a Volkswagen Jetta travelling on Hwy. 3 near Liverpool that had hit at least four vehicles without stopping. The collisions caused non-life-threatening injuries to some other drivers.

Officers conducted patrols in the area and located the vehicle parked at a gas station. When officers told the driver, identified as Jason MacLeod, that he was under arrest, he resisted and assaulted them.

Officers used a conducted energy weapon and oleoresin capsicum spray before MacLeod was taken into custody. He was transported to hospital for treatment of non-life-threatening injuries and was later released to police.

MacLeod, 48, of Liverpool, has been charged with: Dangerous operation of a motor vehicle; failing to stop at the scene of a collision (hit and run);

resisting arrest (3x) and assaulting a police officer (2x).

- Dangerous Operation of a Motor Vehicle
- Failing to Stop at the Scene of a Collision (Hit and Run)
- Resisting Arrest (three counts),
- Assaulting a Police Officer (two counts)

He was released by police on conditions pending a first court appearance at Bridgewater Provincial Court Sept. 9.

Two of the RCMP officers involved in the arrest were treated in hospital for non-life-threatening injuries.

The investigation is ongoing.

Anyone with information about these incidents, including victims of the hit and run collisions who've not yet spoken with police, or anyone with dashcam footage showing MacLeod operating a grey Volkswagen Jetta on Hwy. 3 on the afternoon of July 3, is asked to contact Queens District RCMP at 902-354-5721. 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Grilled Summer Bowtie Salad

INGREDIENTS

PASTA

- 12 oz (340 g) bowtie (farfalle) pasta
- Salted water for boiling
- 2 ears of fresh corn, husked
- 2 medium zucchini, sliced lengthwise into planks
- 1 cup cherry or grape tomatoes (left whole for charring)
- Olive oil, for brushing
- Salt and black pepper
- ½ cup fresh blueberries
- ½ cup fresh strawberries, hulled and quartered
- ¼ cup fresh dill, roughly chopped
- 3 green onions, thinly sliced
- Optional: ¼ cup crumbled feta cheese

CREAMY-TANGY DRESSING

- 1/3 cup sour cream or plain Greek yogurt
- 3 tablespoons mayonnaise
- 2 tablespoons apple cider vinegar
- 1 tablespoon fresh lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon Dijon mustard
- 1 teaspoon honey
- 1 small garlic clove, minced
- Salt and freshly ground black pepper, to taste
- 2-3 tablespoons water (to thin to desired consistency)

PREPARATION

1. Cook the pasta. Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil. Cook bowtie pasta according to package directions until al dente. Drain, rinse with cold water, and toss with a drizzle of olive oil. Set aside to cool completely.
2. Prep the grill. Preheat an outdoor grill or grill pan to medium-high heat. Lightly oil the grates.
3. Grill the vegetables. Brush corn and zucchini planks with olive oil and season with salt and pepper. Grill corn for 10-12 minutes, turning occasionally, until charred in spots. Grill zucchini for 3-4 minutes per side until tender with grill marks. Place cherry tomatoes in a grill basket or on foil; grill for 5-7 minutes until blistered and slightly burst. Remove everything from the grill and let cool slightly.
4. Prep the grilled vegetables. Cut corn kernels from the cob. Chop zucchini into bite-sized pieces. Leave charred tomatoes whole or halve if large.
5. Make the dressing. Whisk together sour cream (or Greek yogurt), mayonnaise, apple cider vinegar, lemon juice, Dijon mustard, honey, and garlic in a small bowl.

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# Lunenburg council highlights from June 23

## NEW TRACKLESS MACHINE APPROVED

Council approved the purchase of a new Trackless sidewalk maintenance machine and attachments from Saunders Equipment for \$187,302 plus HST. The purchase was included in the Town’s approved 2026–27 Capital Budget.

The Trackless machine is used by Public Works for sidewalk snow clearing and salting during the winter months and street sweeping throughout the year. The new unit will supplement the town’s existing machine, improving service reliability and providing backup equipment when maintenance or repairs are required.

The purchase came in under the amount budgeted in the town’s approved capital budget.

## SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY RECEIVES NOTICE

Council gave notice that it will consider adopting a new Social Media Policy at its July 14, 2026 meeting. The proposed policy would establish guidelines for how the Town uses and manages its official social media accounts, including content standards, account oversight, and public interaction on Town-managed platforms.

A key feature of the proposed policy is that comments and public replies on official Town of Lunenburg social media accounts would generally be turned off by default, while still allowing the town to enable comments for specific projects, public engagement initiatives, emergencies, or other situations where public interaction is appropriate.

The proposed policy applies only to official social media accounts operated by the town and would not apply to the personal social media accounts of individual council members. Residents would continue to have other ways to engage with the town, including contacting staff, contacting council members directly, attending meetings, and participating in public engagement opportunities.

Council was expected to consider the policy for final approval at its July 14 meeting. The draft policy is available in the agenda package for this meeting.

# One dead after Lilydale crash

LILYDALE - The Lunenburg District RCMP is investigating a fatal crash that happened in this community.

On July 11, at approximately 6:40 a.m., Lunenburg District RCMP, fire services, and EHS responded to a report of a single-vehicle crash on Hwy. 324.

Upon arrival, officers learned that a Ford Bronco, travelling southeast, had left the roadway and struck a tree.

The youth driver and a youth passenger were pronounced deceased at the scene. A third occupant of the vehicle, another youth, was transported to hospital by EHS LifeFlight with life-threatening injuries.

An RCMP collision reconstructionist attended the scene. Hwy. 324 was closed for several hours but has since reopened.

The investigation remains ongoing with assistance from the Nova Scotia Medical Examiner Service.

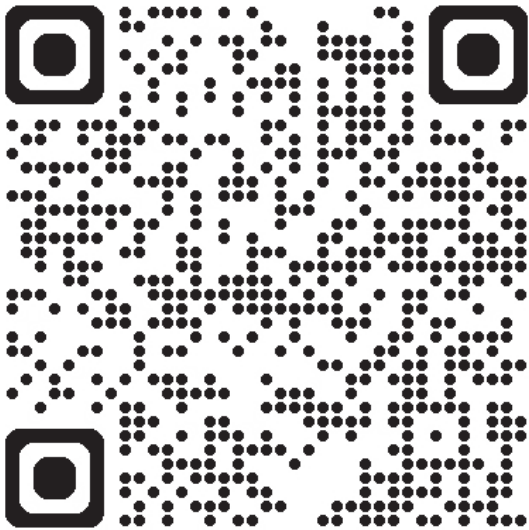

# Local traces Hatt family history

## Invites Switzerland relatives to join in reunion

How far can anyone go back in family history?

“That question has always been on my mind,” said Evelyn Snyder, whose curiosity over the past 30 years plus, has taken her as far back as the 1500s...rooted in Hemmental, Switzerland.

After visiting Switzerland in 2024 with her partner, Bob they were able to visit some relatives and tour much of the area. On Aug. 2, Snyder and the Canadian relatives will welcome Hatt relatives from Switzerland and everywhere else for a massive reunion on the South Shore.

“We have so much history to share. I think every family should search out and discovery their history. By know the hardship that it took to get here, maybe we would appreciate a bit what we have and be more community minded and involved and more protective of one another,” she said.

On her history quest, Snyder said much of her information came from her grandmother, Hannah Hatt, who died in 1972 at the age of 102.

“I remember her stories as if they were today. I decided that once I retired, I would trace some of her stories and try to create a family tree,” she said. “Finally, some 30 years later, I have finally arrived at the beginning of the Canadian Hatt family in 1749. Now I can trace the family history back into the 1500s in Hemmental.”

Along with her grandmother she also credits Dr. Willian Swasey Hatt who wrote the book, Hang on to Your Hatts, and Winthrop Bell who wrote a history on the Nova Scotian foreign prot-estants.

The Canadian story begins with several sailing ships that departed from London and Rotherham between 1749 and 1752. Ship names included the Sally, Murdok, Alderney, Nancy, Gale, Pearl, Betty the Ann and the Speedwell. These ships made a total of 12 voyages to Halifax.

History has it that several of the Hatts and Leu family left Hemmental in 1749, a small, isolated valley settlement, 30 miles from Zurich with a population of 500 at the time. This small, rural village is now a quiet community that hasn’t changed, with an estimated 520 people.

In the 1600s, there were only four family sur-names found in the village when it was founded – Hatt, Lue’, Schlatter and Mettler and the Coat of Arms bears their names. Only three surnames remain today. The Mettler name as vanished.

Many of the homes in the village can be dated back to 1539 and a Matthias family home from the 1700s is still standing, although it no longer belongs to the Hatt family.

### IN SWITZERLAND...

Snyder said there are not any hotels to stay in Hemmental, so they were invited to stay with a couple, Matthias and Gesela Lue. They toured around the village and Snyder said it was like they were back in the 1600s – the school, the town hall and fire department are all in the same building. The only church in the town was the Saint Nicolas church which dates back to 1492.

“This was so wonderful to finally have a real place (location) from start to finish of my quest for discovering my heritage,” said Snyder. “It was very satisfying to be able to leave with this knowledge and to go back home to Nova Scotia and tell family members the story of their history from the 1600s and into today.”

### WHY DID THEY COME TO NOVA SCOTIA?

The immigrants from Europe came because of the promise of free land and to have the freedom to

work their own land.

“There was a lot of turmoil in many parts of Europe at the time and the economy was not strong, leaving many people in deep poverty. Thus, the offer to come to the New World appeared attractive to many from Germany, Eng-land, Switzerland, France and other countries,” explained Snyder.

“They were offered free passage, free food for two years and free land. The promise was for a lot consisting of 300 acres that they could use to farm, fish and to build family homes.”

### WHEN DID THEY ARRIVE?

The Speedwell arrived in Halifax on July 23, 1751 with 212 passengers on board. For political and health reasons, they were detained in Halifax until the next year, when they finally received permission to sail to Lunenburg.

They arrived there in May of 1753 to Lunenburg to make their new home.

The Town of Lunenburg was formally founded in June of 1753 and the Hatts were one of the founding members.

The Hatts, like all the other foreign protectants had many hardships to overcome, said Snyder. In her research, many survived and thrived, some starting large families and one family, had 22.

By the mid-1800s, some Hatts married and moved away to settle in other places. Those who stayed in the area helped build a strong economy centred on shipbuilding, forestry and fishing.

Snyder said she was surprised to discover that many of them were shipbuilders, farmers, fisher-men, blacksmiths and millwrights. The first gen-eration built 38 ships on Tancook Island and Port Medway. As well, the Hatts are famous for their Tancook Sauerkraut, an enterprise started by M.A. Hatt & Son and thrived until 2022.

Other notable Hatt family members include Hank Snow, whose mother had a close family connection. Hank visited Snyder’s grandmother every time he returned to Nova Scotia.

More recently, a British cousin, John Hatt, also made a name for himself by founding the company, Cheap Flights. He was also the travelling speech writher to Queen Elizabeth and Stephen Harper

when the Queen would come to Canada.

As well, Snyder’s uncle, Thomas Hatt, died in the Halifax Explosion in 1917.

### THIS AUGUST

This August, Snyder will be welcoming Matthias and his wife Gisela (Lue) and his niece, Monica Hatt, to Nova Scotia for their first time ever, to meet his cousins.

A tour of Lunenburg is at the top of their agenda including a stop at the Foreign Protestant monu-ment and the Anglican Church where a family of Hatt’s are believed to be buried.

The mayor of Lunenburg, MODL Mayor Elspeth McLean Wile and MLA Susan Corkum Greek will welcome them here, along with other Hatts from across Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and other parts of Canada and the U.S.A. She is also expecting a few relatives from Bermuda, Australia and Great Britain.

A week-long celebration and family has been set aside.

# Records are falling

## Local athlete breaks provincial pentathlon record

BRIDGEWATER – It’s all in the family.

Deacon Crouse just recently broke an Athletics Nova Scotia Track and Field Outdoor provincial u16 pentathlon record with 2,730 points (June 27).

During the provincial championships, he finished with a personal best in hurdles with 15.91; a 5.20 in long jump; a 10.40 m throw in shot put; 1.69 m in high jump and a good finish in his 1,000 m and triple jump events.

This past weekend, he threw farther and ran harder, setting a new personal best point total of 2,783, at the Athletics Nova Scotia Royal Canadian Legion track and field trials. He had a personal best in the long jump at 5.24 m and stayed under 16 seconds in hurdles and ran a new personal best in the 1,000 m race.

Crouse is just 13, born in October 2002 and attends Hebbville Academy.

He is a multi-sport+ athlete, competing in track, basketball, soccer, baseball, cross country, softball, volleyball and he throws in the occasional golf game.

He says that track is at the top of his list when it comes to sports and said he wouldn’t mind going to post-secondary as a track athlete. To break down the track side of things even further, he loves the triple jump and high jump events.

In the pentathlon, athletes compete in the 100m hurdles, high jump, long jump, shot put and one kilometre race. He began specifically training for the pentathlon “two or three months ago.”

He is a member of the GRITS athletics in the city and tries to get in once or twice a week.

Was he surprised, when he first set the record?

“I was really surprised. I am only first year U16 so I get to try and beat that again,” he said.

His best event in the pentathlon is the 1 K after having competed in cross-country for several years. He said this gives him a bit of an advantage since many of the pentathlon competitors don’t focus on the running portion, but more jumping or throwing.

The one event that he could work on a bit more, he says, is the shot put.

He comes by his athletic prowess quite naturally. His mother, Gillian (Rafuse) owned the track from 1999 to 2004. She was undefeated in Nova Scotia for five years, placing top five in the country for the 100 m and sixth for the 200 m.

She said she broke the junior girls record for 100m, 200m and 400m in her first year and re-broke them in her second year. She, and her medley

team, also brought home a gold medal from the Legion nationals in Calgary.

Her provincial records in the 100m, 200m and 400m still stand.

“To say that I am proud of him is a massive understatement. I find far more enjoyment in watching him succeed in track than I ever did competing personally,” said Gillian. “He may have my genes, but he shows far more dedication and puts in the work and that’s what makes him stand out as his own person and amazing athlete.”

Deacon said that she has had a big influence on his young career.

“She coaches me a lot and she’s always pushing me to excel in everything,” he said, adding that she is very good at knowing and giving him the best nutrition.

This year’s run started at junior high school districts when he beat the district triple jump record by jumping 11.55 m – 62 cm longer than a record set 21 years ago. He also competed in high jump, the 4x400m race, long jump, javelin and the 1,500 m race, earning four gold and a bronze.

In regionals, he beat the regional triple jump record (from 1991) with a personal best of 11.74 m and a first in javelin with a personal best of 38.18 m.

“This was pretty difficult, because my 1,500 m and javelin were scheduled for the same time, so I



had to run, then come back and throw the javelin,” he said. “I must have had a lot of energy from that. I threw the javelin really far and came in first in that, which made me pretty happy.”

Crouse said that there was a bit more at stake at the regionals.

“My mom said that if I broke the regional record, she was going to get me some triple jump spikes,” he said. “I broke it and got the spikes, but sadly I didn’t get to use them before provincials.”

At provincials he did well, but said it was a “big mess.” Many of the events were at the same time, which made things difficult.

He finished third in javelin and long jump and first in triple jump, he thought he was about 14 cm off the provincial record – a personal best of 11.89 metres.

In his first pentathlon at the Grit Athletics Open held June 6-7, he finished first in three events – the 1,000 m race, the 100 metre hurdles and the high jump. He finished second in long jump and shot put.

Key to his success? “Rest and recovery is important. I’m always doing something, but I do need to take days off.”

Next up for Deacon is the 2026 Atlantic Track and Field championships that will take place July 25-26 in Truro.

## New \$8.1-million outdoor pool set to open in Liverpool

The municipality offered subsidized Bronze Cross training and free swim instructor training for Queens County residents interested in working at the new pool and at the North Queens Aquatic Centre in Caledonia.

“It’s something that is a challenge that’s being experienced by (recreation) departments, sort of across the board,” Christian said.

“But we were able to attract a decent number of folks to be able to provide recreation programming and swim instruction services at the North Queens Pool and the new pool.”

Starting next year, the pool is expected to be open from June 1 to Sept. 30, and cost about \$112,000 annually to operate, according to estimates pre-

pared by the region’s Recreation Director Meaghan Roberts.

“I’m not sure in terms of hours of operations and the amount of swim lessons and different types of programs that will be available,” Christian said.

“This is a bit of a dry run for the new pool. It’s a bit of a test year, if you will.”

He said one of the challenges is to find staff who aren’t returning to school in September, so the pool can stay open after Labour Day.

“The facility that’s in there allows us to heat the pool so it’s a comfortable temperature for longer periods of the year. It’s a challenge to get lifeguards who don’t go back to school in September. So, we’re going to continue to engage the community and try to attract people to that so that we can have that expansive season,” said Christian.

# Chester school playground fundraising campaign needs help over the hump

CHESTER – Work on a new \$350,000 playground at Chester District School could begin by the end of August.

A local fundraising committee has been working since Spring 2025 to bring an inclusive play space to the school, which has about 275 students in pre-Primary to Grade 4.

The existing equipment is about 20 years old and consists of six swings and a climbing structure.

And if the volunteer fundraising committee can get approval soon from the South Shore Regional Centre for Education, they can begin ordering equipment so contractors can start by the end of summer.

“A lot of the equipment had been removed due to it falling apart and so our elementary school barely has what I would even call a playground,” says Katie Cook, a member of the CDS play space committee. She has two children entering Grade 2 and Grade 4 in September.

“It isn’t ideal and it’s a community space as well. Something new and accessible was needed. So, we needed to upgrade everything so that there was a healthy, active playground space where all the kids could come and play.”

Cook and other volunteers have raised about \$250,000 so far in grants. The Chataway Haughn Trust and the Municipality of the District of Chester have each contributed \$100,000. They’ve received another \$50,000 from other funding sources.

“We’re very happy that we got the funding we did. But we’re not there yet and we are struggling to get to that final amount.”

Volunteers have also held small fundraisers to help raise more money. But they need another \$100,000.

Cook says they’ve begun reaching out to local businesses for support. They will be recognized for their contributions, with the top donors’ names on permanent playground signage.

“Back when I was growing up in the ’80s and

’90s, you could fund these things with some bake sales, and some people could build their own equipment, and now everything has to be OKed by the school board at a certain level of certification.”

Committee members also learned that school boards do not fund new playgrounds at existing schools. So, the community has to raise the money.

Chester District School is a community-use school, so that means that the playground is also available to be used by any members of the community.

“We’re trying to get something done this summer because a lot of us who have been running this (campaign), our kids are going to be out of the school by the time most of it is built.”

The committee surveyed current students to find out what they wanted in a new playground. The new space is also required to have three different age-appropriate zones.

“The kids have been troopers in terms of, you know, they’re creative. There’s a little hill there that they make into a mountain at playtime,” but she says there just isn’t enough modern equipment.

“I live near the school, and oftentimes, my kids are begging me to drive them to other playgrounds.”

Cook said they’re waiting for approval from the school board to buy the largest piece of equipment for the grades 3-4 playground.

And volunteers recently learned they’ll have to upgrade the groundwork around existing structures from pea gravel to a treated wood carpet, which will provide a cushioned, accessible surface. But that will also add an unexpected cost.

Cook says she hopes they can garner enough support from local businesses to help get the new play space past the finish line and give local kids a safe place to play.

“Some of the children that come into the school, the only opportunity they really get to play on play structures like this is at school at recess. And since my kids have been there, there’s really been very little for them to play with or on.”

# Municipal governments team up

## New online system for permits

SOUTH SHORE - Some South Shore municipal governments are teaming up on a new online system they say will make it easier to apply for building and planning permits.

The Region of Queens is joining the Town of Bridgewater, the Town of Lunenburg and the Municipality of the District of Lunenburg in launching a regional permit portal.

The online system, which went live on Monday, is designed to make it easier for people to apply for and track building, development, demolition or subdivision permits. It also allows people to submit a bylaw violation complaint, request a power connection or check on zoning for individual properties.

One account applies across all four municipalities. Users can upload documents and photos and track their application’s process as it’s reviewed.

“We’re trying to harmonize and align our procedures and practices so that they’re copasetic across the municipalities that we do share services with,” Queens Mayor Scott Christian said in an interview.

“It should lead to more efficiency, both on the front end and the back end. Easier to submit, not have to do kind of hand-drawn applications. So that’s been something that the municipality has been looking to do for quite some time. We’re at the point where we’re starting to implement that.”

Municipalities already share some services like bylaw enforcement, planning and building inspection.

People can still apply using paper forms or by visiting their local municipal offices.

**IN 2017**

A “Gathering of the Hatts” in 2017 was kind of a warm-up to this year’s event.

Snyder had put together a long list of cousins, both near and far over 30 years of research into the Hatt family and they were all invited for a big, family reunion.

Snyder had visited families and visited hats around Nova Scotia.

“The idea stirred much interest and some cousins and family members wanted to help in arranging the reunion,” she said. “There was a great turnout and I learned a lot more family history.”

There were 80 who attended dinner in Lunenburg with Hatts coming from New Brunswick, Ontario and Nova Scotia.

**RESEARCH CONTINUES**

Despite more than three decades of research,

travel, phone calls and e-mails, Snyder still has questions like does she still have cousins in Hemmental? What happened to the Hatts who stayed behind?

With the help of Google and worldwide telephone data bases she did find some answers by tracking down seven family members related to the 1753 Hatt’s still living in Hemmental, a direct line to the Nova Scotia Hatts.

Although many didn’t speak English, a second round of phone calls to Gisla Hatt, wife of Matthias answered her phone and spoke some English. The two exchanged e-mails and phone calls – she know the Hatt history well and sent information about Matthias’s family tree which shoed the connection to the Hatts and Leu families of Nova Scotia.

## Lane’s Privateer Inn

Come for the history, stay for the food

Lane’s Privateer Inn in Liverpool, is steeped in a unique maritime sea-faring history. The story behind the Inn is as remarkable as the food, service and atmosphere.

This Liverpool landmark was built in 1798 by mariner, merchant and politician Joseph Barss Sr. as a family home. The grand structure, a three-storey dwelling, stood out from the beginning. Each floor had four rooms, all adorned with fireplaces and other timely affluent features.

Captain Joseph Barss Jr., one of the most successful privateers in the North Atlantic, took over the home- stead from his father.

Barss Jr. first gained experience as a privateer against the French. He later captained the Liverpool Pack- et during the war of 1812. Built in Baltimore, the vessel, originally an American slave ship named ‘Severn’, was captured by the English in 1811.

The ship was issued letters of marque by Lt. Governor Sherbrooke, allowing maritime commerce raid-

ing during commission of war. The private schooner, in turn, captured 50 enemy vessels while creating fear and trepidation on the high seas. The seized bounty was shared between the crown, vessel, captain and crew.

After the war, Captain Barss moved inland. Over time, the original build- ing was expanded and became Lane’s Privateer Inn in 1962. The wooden

beams of the original structure can still be found in the reception area, gourmet shop and the corridor lead- ing to the restaurant and pub.

Stepping into the restaurant a portrait of Captain Barss hanging in the middle of the boldly lit bar, surrounded by beverages in antique gilded frames, grabs your attention. Seating is accentuated with captain’s

chairs and upholstered benches. A fireplace evokes coziness while the view of the Mersey River elicits relax- ation and tranquillity. For a serene taste of the outdoors there is a back- yard patio.

The All Day Favourites, Lunch, and Dinner Menus provide several enticing options. Soup is made daily. Creamy haddock and seafood chow- der are fresh. Classic fish and chips and traditional clams are a staple.

A huge bonus; you can opt for a side garden salad at no extra cost. Want to upgrade your side? Choose from soup, a beet, greek, or Caesar salad, sweet potato fries and onion rings. Lobster roll, poutine, burgers and Lane’s best-selling haddock cakes with baked beans, chow, and garden salad round out the all day menu.

Lunch is on the light side with sandwiches, fish and chicken burgers and paninis added to the All Day Favourites. Many items can be pre- pared gluten free, and daily specials are available.

# Looking beyond the diagnosis:

## Understanding FIV in cats

When a cat tests positive for Feline Immunodeficiency Virus (FIV), many people assume that life will be short or difficult. In reality, many FIV-positive cats go on to live long, happy, and loving lives. With the right home and proper care, these cats can make wonderful companions.

At SHAID Tree Animal Shelter, one special cat is helping to change the way people think about FIV. Meet Myles, a loving four-year-old male whose journey is one of resilience, recovery, and hope.

When Myles first arrived at the shelter, he was in very poor condition. It was clear he had been through a great deal while living on his own. After receiving veterinary care, he was diagnosed as FIV-positive and also tested positive for both lyme disease and anaplasmosis. Thanks to prompt medical treatment, good nutrition, and plenty of love from shelter staff and volunteers, Myles has made an incredible recovery and is now feeling much better.

Through it all, one thing never changed, his affectionate personality. Myles adores people. His gentle nature has quickly made him a staff favourite, and everyone at SHAID is hoping someone will look beyond his diagnosis and see the amazing companion waiting for a forever home.

So, what exactly is FIV?

Feline Immunodeficiency Virus is a virus that affects a cat's immune system, making it harder for the body to fight off infections. While this may sound

alarming, many FIV-positive cats remain healthy for many years and often live lifespans comparable to cats without the virus when they receive regular veterinary care and live in a safe indoor environment.

Unlike illnesses that spread easily through casual contact, FIV is transmitted almost exclusively through deep bite wounds, which is why it is most commonly found in unneutered male cats that have spent time fighting outdoors. It is not spread through sharing food or water dishes, using the same litter box, grooming one another, or simply living in the same home under peaceful conditions.

When we choose to give up

What does it mean to “give up”? Perhaps the first picture that comes to your mind is surrender. We’ve thrown our hands in the air, reached our limit, “That’s it; I’m done.”

Sounds pretty negative, doesn’t it?

On the other hand, giving up can be a helpful, indeed a necessary step toward improving our lives. In recent columns, I’ve taken a look at basic human needs: needs that include freedom, fun, love/belonging and more.

To satisfy those needs, we often focus on what we want to gain. What do we need to add to have the life we want? Now, here’s another piece to consider: What do we want to give up?

Many decisions, especially difficult ones, involve tradeoffs. We can

have one thing but not another. An easy example is diet: we can have the whole cheesecake or we can have the weight we want on the bathroom scale. That’s a tradeoff.

Tradeoffs can be difficult. Take smoking, for example. We know that giving it up is the right thing to do, but that doesn’t make it easy. What are we trading off? Health versus a comforting habit, perhaps.

Choice Theory suggests that we learn “deadly habits” such as criticizing, blaming and complaining, and that using those habits destroys relationships.

What do you think? Do you know people who use those habits? Do you use them yourself? I think it’s a rare person indeed who can say that they never do.

Choosing to give up even one of those habits could help to improve important relationships, whether at

work, among friends, or within the household.

For example, when presented with the opportunity to complain (by the way, there will always be opportunities to complain) we can ask ourselves questions. Will my complaint have a positive effect on the situation? Or negative? Do I want to complain? Or will I choose not to? We can make a choice.

Giving up those deadly habits can help to improve our relationships. But wait; there’s more! We might have other habits that could stand some scrutiny. Are they really serving us? Are they serving anyone?

One habit is resentment; dwelling on past hurts and unfairness. It’s “fair” to say that when pressed, any one of us could come up with an example from our past when we have been hurt unnecessarily or treated unfairly.

So, the question is not so much, “Do I have a right to resent?” Perhaps you do. However, more useful questions may be, “How long do I want to carry this? Have I suffered enough by now? Do I want to give it up?”

Another habit that’s worth considering for the trash heap is the habit of comparing ourselves with

others. It can be hard to give it up! In our connected world, we have so many opportunities to see what other people have, how they live, the exciting things they’re doing. It can make even a contented life look mundane by comparison.

And there’s the rub: “By comparison.” If you set your own standard, decide for yourself what life you want to live, then it doesn’t matter what other people’s lives look like, does it? You can still appreciate their joys, but when you know what you want in your own life, you will not be so easily swept off course when you see someone else’s latest adventure or newest trinket.

Are there habits in your life that would benefit from being tossed out? Try asking yourself: Does this behaviour help me in any way? Is it helpful for anyone else? Does this habit bring me closer to the life I want to lead? Or is it leading me away?

The best way to prevent FIV is by keeping cats indoors, having them spayed or neutered to reduce territorial fighting, and avoiding situations where cats may come into contact with aggressive outdoor cats.

For cats already living with FIV, an indoor-only lifestyle is especially important. Keeping them indoors protects their immune systems from unnecessary exposure to illness and helps prevent injuries that could lead to infection.

At SHAID, FIV-positive cats like Myles are adopted into homes where they will either be the only cat or live with another FIV-positive cat. This approach ensures the health and well-being of all the cats in the household while giving FIV-positive cats the opportunity to thrive.

Perhaps the biggest misconception about FIV is that it defines a cat. It doesn’t.

Cats like Myles still enjoy chasing toys, stretching out in sunny windows, greeting their people at the door, and curling up beside someone they love. They simply need a family willing to understand their diagnosis and provide routine veterinary care, good nutrition, and a safe place to call home.

Myles has already overcome tremendous challenges in his life. Now

he’s simply waiting for someone to give him the second chance he deserves. His story is a reminder that some of the most rewarding companions are the ones who have had to fight the hardest to get where they are today.

All about the Nelson’s Sparrow

On June 28 I had the privilege of both seeing and hearing Nelson’s Sparrows at Oxner’s Beach. This is the last sparrow to return here in migration and thus is a late breeder. In recent years numbers of these sparrows have dropped around here due to habitat removal.

This sparrow with the recent name change from Nelson’s Sharp-tailed Sparrow breeds in British Columbia and east across Canada to North Dakota and in the James Bay area of Canada, along the Atlantic coast and from Quebec and Nova Scotia south to North Carolina. They winter along the coast from New York to Florida and west along the Gulf Coast to Texas.

The Nelson’s sparrow is 12.5 to 15 cm long with the sexes being outwardly alike. They are a small marsh sparrow with a rich buff triangle on side of the face, gray ear patches and light streaks on a gray-brown back. They have an unstreaked blackish cap and the breast and flanks are pale buff.

The Nelson’s sparrow eats ants, beetles, weevils, grasshoppers, caterpillars, moths, leafhoppers, flies, amphipods, spiders, small snails and seeds of grasses, weeds and wild rice.

Steven Morris located a great egret at Beach Meadows on July 4. Kevin Lantz reported a great horned owl and two young at Lilydale. The common loon is still sitting on a nest at Steverman’s Lake and the young should be

hatching in a couple of days. There also has been up to four wood ducks at the lake. Four piping plover chicks have hatched at Hirtle’s Beach, so please watch out for them when you are visiting this beach.

Things were relatively quiet across the province. On July 5 Jason Dain had four black terns at the Amherst Marsh. On a pelagic off Brier Island Logan LaLonde and some other bird-

ers saw 140 Wilson’s storm petrels, 14 northern fulmars, 18 red phalaropes, two red-necked phalaropes, with hundreds of greater shearwaters and some sooty and manx shearwaters mixed in. He had a Hudsonian whimbrel at Gull Rock Point.

On July 6 JD Bharvad reported an American oystercatcher at Big Glace Bay in Cape Breton. Kyle d’Entremont had two little blue herons at Rainbow Haven. On July 7 Charles Sterns located a great egret at Burnside. Logan Moore heard two Virginia rails at the Brookside Marsh. Jason Dain reported a yellow-throated warbler at Boutilier Branch Road.

Richard Stern saw a great egret at the Guzzle in the Valley. Rick Whitman at this location saw a short-billed dowitcher, two semi-palmated sandpipers, five least sandpipers and 32 peeps signifying that the shorebirds are on the way in migration. Andrew Bates sighted two Tennessee warblers at Blomidon Provincial Park and an Eastern bluebird near Pereau Road.

A bouquet, not a bud vase

Picture a 30-degree day on the South Shore, the kind of heat that makes the pavement shimmer and the whole town move a little slower. In one business, the room sits empty, the owner is wiping down machines that don’t need wiping and the brain starts drafting the plan. Change the hours, cut the mid-shift, maybe summer isn’t our season.

Around the corner, it’s the same temperature and another business has its busiest day of the year. The till running hot, items are dancing off the shelves and that owner’s brain is drafting the opposite plan. We need more staff. More space. Maybe it’s time to expand.

Same weather, same week and two completely different “obvious” conclusions and both are considering making a big decision based on a single afternoon.

A single day is not a signal. It’s a data point wearing a costume and if you’ve ever owned a business, led a team, or managed anything with a front door, you know exactly how convincing that costume can be. The slow Tuesday whispers that you’re failing. The record Saturday shouts that you should double down on everything. Both are lying to you, or at least, both are telling you far less than they claim to be.

Imagine cutting one flower from your garden and putting it in a bud

vase on the windowsill. It’s lovely. It’s also completely misleading. That one stem tells you nothing about the garden, not what’s thriving, not what’s struggling, not what the season is actually doing. One perfect rose can come from a garden full of weeds. One wilted daisy can come from the healthiest bed on the street.

Imagine instead you walk the garden every day and cut one stem each time. The scorcher when nobody came, the scorcher when everybody came, the rainy Thursday that surprised you, the long weekend that didn’t, the employee who quit, the customer who raved. You gather them all and you’re not staring at a single flower anymore, you’re holding a bouquet. A bouquet tells the truth in a way a bud vase never can. You can see the season in it, the patterns, what keeps showing up, and what was just one strange bloom.

Reacting is arranging your whole business around a single stem. Leading is waiting until you have enough flowers to see the actual arrangement.

This is the hard part.

Collecting without reacting still means paying attention. This isn’t permission to ignore what’s happening. You don’t get to shrug off empty because “it’s just one day” and never think about it again. You clip that stem. You note it. Hot day, no customers, festival two towns over, highway construction out front. You put it in the basket with the rest. The discipline isn’t in ignoring the data, it’s

in refusing to let one day write your strategy for you.

Businesses rarely fail from one bad day. They fail from a hundred overreactions to bad days. Hours changed, then changed back, until customers can’t remember when you’re open. Menus and product lines gutted after one slow week. Staff cut after a quiet stretch, then nobody left standing when the rush returns. Prices yo-yoed. Marketing abandoned mid-campaign. Every pivot made in a panic, every single stem treated like the whole garden.

The same is true inside your team. One employee has an off shift and suddenly you’re questioning the hire. One glowing review and suddenly they’re untouchable. People, like businesses, deserve to be read as bouquets, patterns over time, not judged by whatever single stem happens to be in the vase today.

When something dramatic happens, good or bad, try this. Don’t decide anything. Just clip it, label it, and put it in the basket. Ask yourself: is this a pattern, or is this Tuesday? Give it two weeks, a month, a quarter, then look at the whole bouquet and ask what it’s actually telling you.

The bud vase is prettier in the moment. The bouquet is what you build a business on.

Arnold "Arnie" Edward Mailman

Surrounded by loving family and treasured mementos from his military career, Arnie passed away at age 88, at Dartmouth General Hospital following a brief illness. He faced his death with the same honor, bravery, caring and bit of humour, that he displayed his entire life. Born in Nineveh, Lunenburg Co., Nova Scotia on September 1, 1937, to the late Wilfred and Freda (Crouse) Mailman; he passed on Tuesday, June 30, 2026. Arnie grew up in Bridgewater, graduating from Bridgewater High School in 1957, and where he met Margaret Ann (nee Cleversey) who he married in 1958. Margaret Ann, Arnie's wife of 67 years, survives him. Arnie joined the Royal Canadian Navy in 1958 and following basic training at HMCS Cornwallis, was stationed at CFB Shearwater. A final posting in 1987 was to Ottawa to the Aircrew Chemical Defense Program, as Chief Warrant Officer. This completed Arnie's 34 years' service in all three elements of the Canadian Forces. Chief Warrant Officer Mailman was awarded the Canadian Forces Decoration (CD) with two clasps, as well as the Canadian Centennial Medal (CCM). Upon retirement in 1993 Arnie and Margaret Ann returned to their province of Nova Scotia and to their family. They developed a piece of property on Birchtown Bay, Shelburne County, which provided a peaceful retirement of twenty-six years. # Liverpool important link in fast-charging station network, NSP official says

LIVERPOOL – Two electric vehicle fast-charging stations in Liverpool may not be the busiest, but they're a vital link in Nova Scotia Power's network around the province, company officials said Wednesday, July 8, at an event to promote the stations and EV use.

"It goes with the traffic flow," said Ed Cullinan, NSP's senior manager of e-mobility and residential electrification.

"So major highways, as you might expect, are busier than the smaller tributaries and charging stations in the town. We're happy to bring charging

into places like Liverpool because it connects the whole province and really makes sure that people know that they can get around no matter where they want to go."

The company and the Region of Queens held a ribbon-cutting at the site located next to Hell Bay Brewing in downtown Liverpool. The region didn't spend any money on the stations, but it allowed Nova Scotia Power to install them in public parking spots near Hell Bay.

"We're very pleased to have them here. We see it as a great reason for people to come off (Highway) 103 and access the downtown," Mayor Scott Christian said.

"We think it's really great for our small businesses, giving people another reason to get off at Exit 19."

Christian said he and other municipal officials had heard that tourists arriving in Yarmouth via the Cat ferry would take Highway 101 and drive through the Annapolis Valley to access charging stations there, instead of continuing on the 103.

"So, really important from a visitor and tourism economy perspective to ensure that the 103 and the South Shore is an accessible and convenient entry

point for visitors to Nova Scotia."

The two stations can charge up to four vehicles at a time. If one vehicle is hooked up, up to 180 kilowatts is available, for a full charge in under an hour. For two EVs at the same time, it's up to a 90-kW charge. It's much faster than the current stations at Sobeys in Liverpool which max out at 50 kW.

Cullinan said that on average, customers spend about \$20 at a fast-charging station like the ones in Liverpool. He said recharging at home is still slower, but also the most economical at \$9 to \$12.

The Liverpool stations are part of the company's \$10.5-million investment in 15 sites around Nova Scotia in the past year.

He said that Liverpool was a good fit because of the amenities downtown, but also because the municipality was a willing partner.

Also coming... The municipality signed an agreement in July 2025 with Tesla to install eight "Superchargers" at Queens Place Emera Centre, which can recharge up to 322 kilometres in 15 minutes.

Tesla will pay the region \$800 a month in rent. The company said in May it planned to begin construction this summer.

# Bridgewater residents get first look at Generations Active Park as long-awaited project moves toward construction

SOUTH SHORE - After more than a decade of planning, Bridgewater's Generations Active Park is now a step closer to becoming real.

Residents came together on July 9 for a public presentation that shared the latest plans for the multi-use community park, which is expected to be completed by December 2026 and open to the public in the spring of 2027.

The presentation, led by project representative Na-dine Lowes, offered an overview of the park's design, construction schedule, and accessibility features. It also gave community members a chance to ask ques-tions and share their thoughts before work begins.

The project has been in development since 2011, as the Town of Bridgewater looked for options and searched for a company capable of delivering such a large recreational space. That search eventually led to the Glenn Group, a New Brunswick-based firm known for designing multi-use parks across Atlantic Canada.

Although the company has completed projects in Quebec and Ontario, its main focus has stayed in Atlantic Canada. One of its noted projects, Do-minion Park in Saint John, New Brunswick, was highlighted during the presentation as an example

of the firm's way of creating recreational spaces that balance accessibility with natural surroundings.

That same approach is expected to shape Gen-erations Active Park as well. Instead of clearing the property heavily, the design aims to preserve much of the existing forest, letting walking paths, playgrounds, and gathering areas blend naturally into the setting.

Accessibility was repeatedly identified as one of the project's main priorities.

Project representatives explained that the park is being designed so people of all ages and abilities can enjoy the space comfortably, reflecting its goal of serving multiple generations within the community.

While the presentation centered mostly on de-sign, much of the evening's discussion turned to-ward safety and long-term maintenance.

Residents asked about security measures, includ-ing the possible use of surveillance cameras, better lighting, and timed bathroom closures to discour-age late-night loitering and reduce vandalism.

The conversation also touched on construction materials, with attendees asking about the durabil-ity of playground equipment, the kinds of benches to be installed, and the paint finishes planned throughout the park.

Parents showed curiosity regarding the size and layout of playground areas. Others asked about the



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park’s water filtration systems and how the site would be maintained over time.

One resident suggested planting tick-repelling grasses around certain parts of the park to help reduce tick activity, while others recommended clearing brush in areas where visibility might become limited.

Many of the questions focused on practical details to improve both safety and usability without losing the park’s scenic atmosphere.

Project representatives acknowledged the suggestions throughout the evening, noting that community feedback would be taken into account as the



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final design moves closer to construction.

Overall, the response from those attending was positive, with many residents expressing interest in finally seeing the long-awaited project move ahead after so many years of planning.

The faster construction schedule was also welcomed by attendees.

Work is expected to finish by the end of the year, and the project team hopes the park will be ready to welcome visitors when warmer weather returns in the spring of 2027.

If completed on time, Generations Active Park will mark the result of more than 15 years of consultation and design.

As construction begins, Thursday’s meeting served as both a progress update and a chance for residents to help shape the final details of a park meant to serve families, children, seniors, and visitors alike for years to come.



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
